USING ST. MARY'S SANCTUARY DURING THIS PANDEMIC: REQUIREMENTS FOR CLERGY, STAFF, AND MUSICIANS

February 2021

All clergy, staff, and musicians using St. Mary's primary worship space ("sanctuary") for rehearsal, leading worship, or any other function are required to comply with the following requirements, which are based upon Episcopal Diocese of Alaska requirements, Municipality of Anchorage mandates, State of Alaska guidelines, and CDC recommendations and best practices.

- **Number of People Present**
 - The number of people in the sanctuary, narthex, media booth, and Cay's Room combined will not exceed 15.
- **Physical Distancing**
 - When speaking, singing, or playing any wind instrument, a person will maintain a minimum distance of TEN feet from any other person.
 - At every time, a minimum distance of SIX feet between non-household members will be maintained.
- **Physical Barriers**
 - Physical barriers (plexiglass panels) should surround anyone singing or playing a wind instrument. St. Mary's has a limited number of these panels to provide for musicians' use.
- **Face Coverings**
 - Fabric face coverings will be worn over nose and mouth at all times except those specified, below.
 - Face coverings may be removed briefly when necessary for playing musical instruments, consuming Eucharist elements, and in extraordinary circumstances, for speaking or singing. The covering will be promptly replaced at the completion of these activities.
- **Hand Washing/Sanitizing**
 - Frequent handwashing is encouraged.
 - Hand sanitizer will always be available, and should be used frequently.
- **Contact Log**
 - Any time that more than one person is in the sanctuary for more than 15 minutes, a log will be kept of every person present. The log will include full name, phone number, and email address.
